

## **Mandatory Exams Required for entry on 1<sup>st</sup> day of school 2010-2011**

**Students not in compliance with required exams will be unable to attend school until all forms are received in the office**

### **3 Year Pre-School / 1<sup>st</sup> time entering an Illinois School**

Physical exam with all immunizations current  
Diabetes Screening  
Lead screening assessment  
Dental exam or waiver

### **Kindergarten**

Physical exam with all immunizations current  
Diabetes Screening  
Lead screening assessment (61370 zip code is a high risk area)  
Eye exam or waiver by an optometrist or an ophthalmologist  
Dental exam or waiver

### **Second Grade**

Dental exam or waiver

### **Sixth Grade**

Physical exam  
Diabetes Screening  
Dental exam or waiver

### **Miscellaneous Info :**

Any student participating in sports must have a physical each year.

New Illinois State law for the 2008-2009 school year and going forward, any student entering an Illinois school for the 1<sup>st</sup> time and all Kindergarten students will be required to have an eye exam by an optometrist or ophthalmologist. This exam must be completed by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.
